



# **Ohio Living Communities Revenues**




# **Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice Revenues**












# Living the Brand by Recognizing Our Culture







Ohio Living was featured in a new book "Appreciate: Celebrating People, Inspiring Greatness" published by the OC Tanner Institute, our longtime partner for creating organizational culture through world-class recognition. "We have been able to go beyond connecting great recognition practices to the typical metrics — turnover, satisfaction, engagement," says Dana Ullom-Vucelich, chief human resources and ethics

However, what caught our attention is that when locations have high recognition scores their patients also have fewer incidences of infections and pressure sores; improved health department scores; and there is greater continuity of care."

This unique learning experience helps individuals discover what it takes to become a truly cohesive and productive team. # Living the Brand through Social Accountability

In fiscal year 2017, Ohio Living locations across the state found incredible ways to give back to the communities where they do business. This is called social accountability – the community benefit we provide above and beyond the services for which we are paid. This year saw an explosion of creativity as employees found exciting new ways to reach out and also explored how to improve the long-standing traditions of service they had already established.







# **Education**

As always, education was a key element of social accountability for many of our locations. Ranging from diabetes and women's health workshops at Ohio Living Llanfair to safe driving and identity theft prevention classes at Ohio Living Dorothy Love. Seminars on hospice care, arthritis management, pain management and medication were offered in conjunction with local hospitals and pharmacists at Ohio Living Vineyard on Catawba. Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice, greater Columbus offered health education, and greater Youngstown held income tax and veteran benefit seminars.

# **Partnerships**

Many locations intentionally invested in local students this year. Ohio Living Cape May partnered with Wilmington College for internships and volunteer opportunities. Ohio Living Park Vista partnered with Youngstown State University by presenting to their social science program, offering internships, and collaborating on two important programs: VIBE balance research and Music and Memory. Ohio Living Mount Pleasant and Ohio Living Westminster-Thurber provided mock interviews for students and underserved adults to practice their job-seeking skills.

# **Serving Others**

Our employees truly enjoy giving their time and energy to support those in need. Ohio Living Swan Creek served lunch to volunteers at a cancer fundraiser, and Ohio Living Rockynol provided a meal for the community at St. Paul's Episcopal Church. Employees of Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice collected school supplies for homeless children, hosted food drives, donated to their local food banks, and served at Mobile Meals events.

Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice locations provided wellness screenings to area seniors, and Ohio Living Llanfair provided transportation for wheelchair-bound nursing home residents to attend Little Brother Friends of the Elderly programs. A number of corporate staff served on boards and committees dedicated to ensuring the quality of service in our field and finding innovative ways to care for older adults across the country.

There are so many stories of how Ohio Living employees gave back to their communities in fiscal year 2017. Whether it was through "stuffing the bus" with toilet paper and paper towels for a local non-profit, partnering with Opening Minds through Art to provide intergenerational art activities for patients with memory-related illnesses, or baking dog biscuits for their community shelter, we are so proud of the difference we made in our communities this year.







# Total Financial Impact \$21,560,180

The information below illustrates the total financial impact of Ohio Living's community benefit. Each dollar represents our commitment to each community we serve.

# Health Care & Assisted Living Medicaid Charity = \$16,968,000

Medicaid is the state of Ohio's health care funding source for low-income individuals. The dollars in this line item represent the difference between the cost of care at Ohio Living health care and assisted living centers, and the Medicaid or Medicaid Waiver reimbursement for that care.

# Life Care Commitment = \$3,650,000

The Life Care Commitment, with the help of charitable support from the Ohio Living Foundation, assures all Ohio Living residents that

they will always have a home even if – in good faith – they run out of the funds meant to see them through.

Life Plan Communities, Home Health & Hospice, Foundation and Corporate Office = \$882,556 Representing community benefit activities.

#### Honorable Service Grants = \$13,624

We have instituted a program to honor the service of long-standing church workers and those with military service. This program provides significant discounts on fees for apartments and homes at Ohio Living life plan communities.

# Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice Charity = \$46,000

Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice offers a number of home- and community-based services to adults. We work with Passport, local levies, Title XX, United Way, Title III and numerous other funding sources in order to make services available to people of all income levels. The dollars depicted in this line represent the difference between the cost of providing these services and the reimbursement received.

# **New Projects and Services**

Ohio Living Sarah Moore dedicated its new Rehab Center, which offers 19 private and semi-private luxurious suites with private baths and walk-in showers. Additionally, the therapy gym was moved from the basement to the second floor rehab area and provides state-of-the-art equipment. Guests enjoy chef-prepared meals in the new dining room, as well as daily activities and access to all of Ohio Living Sarah Moore's amenities.

Ohio Living Dorothy Love opened the remaining seven rehab studios in July 2016. The Rehab Studios made Ohio Living Dorothy Love the provider of choice for rehabilitation services in the Greater Sidney/Shelby County area with its 20 private rehab studios with spacious accommodations, private baths, and a private dining area.

# Ohio Living Dorothy Love opened the Sargeant Family Center for Aquatic Therapy and Rehab.

The Center was made possible by a successful \$1.5 million capital campaign that was led by a gift from brothers Robert and John Sargeant. The campaign created a new specialized and expanded therapy space for the Rehab Studios that will accommodate a higher number of users, allowing multiple people to comfortably receive therapy at the same time and achieve the best possible outcomes. The Aquatic Therapy program is complemented by The Hydroworx 2000 Therapy Pool. It contains

technological enhancements such as underwater cameras, moveable resistance jets, an integrated treadmill and a rising floor for easy access, which makes it one of the most progressive therapy pools available.

Ohio Living Mount Pleasant was featured in a national news story on the benefits of telemedicine technology. In a "Family 411" segment produced by the Sinclair Broadcast Group, reporter Tara Morgan followed an Ohio Living Mount Pleasant patient and his nurse as they spoke with a doctor remotely to help treat his shortness of breath. The telehealth technology is made possible through TripleCare, which allows patients to speak directly with doctors without having to leave their beds. The doctors work closely with existing nurses and facility doctors to help prevent patients from making an unnecessary trip to the hospital.

Renovations of the independent living dining rooms at Ohio Living Cape May and Ohio Living Llanfair were completed this year, as was the renovation of the Concord Apartments lobby at Ohio Living Vineyard on Catawba.

In early 2016 a five-plex of the original ranch villa homes at Ohio Living Breckenridge Village was demolished to make room for three new villas. Double garages and enhanced floor plans were planned to replace the one car, smaller square-foot units designed and built in 1980.


Two staff from Ohio Living Cape May completed Opening Minds through Art (OMA) facilitator training and then implemented OMA for dementia residents.

# **Partnerships**

Ohio Living was honored to participate in an Elder Care Certification pilot program in conjunction with The Ohio State University's Alber Enterprise Center. Program graduates from Ohio Living Westminster-Thurber were celebrated.

Ohio Living Lake Vista partnered with Trident Health Services to provide a full-time nurse practitioner. Additionally, Unit Manager Erika Parke-Spuhler, RN, became wound certified and leads their wound care program in partnership with Ameriwound. The community also partnered with Respiratory Care Partners to provide a Respiratory Therapist to round with Dr. Thong Truong, medical director, for those with debilitating respiratory conditions. Since implementation, the success of the program has resulted in zero hospital readmissions for patients admitted to the community with diagnosis of congestive heart failure or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease.

A partnership between Ohio Living Cape May and Southern State Community College enables nursing students to complete clinical rotations toward an RN degree.







# **Awards and Recognitions**

Ohio Living Breckenridge Village, Llanfair and Park Vista received deficiency-free skilled nursing standard surveys while Ohio Living Vineyard on Catawba, Cape May and Lake Vista received deficiency-free assisted living surveys.

Ohio Living Cape May, Dorothy Love, Lake Vista, Llanfair, Mount Pleasant and Swan Creek were rated Best Nursing Homes on "U.S. News & World Report's Best Nursing Homes list."

Ohio Living Westminster-Thurber was voted the "Cbus Top Pick" for senior housing in Columbus, according to a readers' poll conducted by "The Columbus Dispatch."

Ohio Living Rockynol received an inaugural Summit Oscars for Aging Resources (SOAR) Award for providing excellence in living environments for older adults. SOAR Awards recognize individuals, businesses and communities that support positive aging.

"The News Herald/Lake County Best of the Best in Senior Living" award was presented to Ohio Living Breckenridge Village.

Ohio Living Sarah Moore took top honors as the No. 1 nursing home in Delaware County. The award was voted on by readers of the "Delaware Gazette" and "Sunbury News" in their annual "Reader's Choice Best of the Best" edition. Ohio Living Sarah Moore was also named the No. 2 retirement facility and No. 2 assisted living facility in the county.

Ohio Living Rockynol was selected for the 2017 Best of Akron Award in the Apartment Buildings category by the Akron Award Program.

Shining a spotlight on those who have made a

significant contribution to the well-being of older adults, LeadingAge Ohio announced that Bob Fischer had been named Board Member of Distinction for his service to Ohio Living Rockynol and Ohio Living Foundation.

Ohio Living Mount Pleasant team members were recognized for their extraordinary action, hard work, and exceptional leadership in evacuating, re-locating, and welcoming back home those residents in the Mount Pleasant Place apartments that were affected by fire in August, 2016. The staff was phenomenal and clearly demonstrated the Ohio Living mission in serving and caring for others!

As a participating member of the Ohio Nursing Home Quality Care Collaborative (NHQCC), Ohio Living Lake Vista was recognized by the Health Services Advisory Group (HSAG) in the "Go for the Gold Recognition Program" as a Platinum Level provider, which is the highest level of recognition!

# **Culinary Excellence**

Chefs from across the Ohio Living life plan communities converged on the Columbus Culinary Institute to turn up the heat at the 4th annual Ohio Living Culinary Competition. The chefs competed in a fast-paced, timed cooking challenge as they competed for gold, silver and bronze medals.

It's because of this commitment to excellence that national magazines and food service organizations placed Ohio Living's exceptional culinary services in the spotlight in fiscal year 2017.

Three articles in the national "Food Service Director" magazine featured Ohio Living Directors of Culinary and Nutritional Services Brian West (Ohio Living Rockynol) and Jason Koprivich (Ohio Living Westminster-Thurber), and Corporate Director of Culinary Services John Andrews.

The Ohio Living Westminster-Thurber culinary team received an Honorable Mention in the On-Site Food Service category in "Foodservice Equipment & Supplies" (FE&S) magazine's 2017 Table Top Awards for their table-scape and the Crossings Restaurant at Goodale Landing.

# **Partnerships**

Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice is the provider for the Ohio Masonic Home and now has offices on their campuses in the Akron, Springfield and Toledo markets. We are also a part of their "Mason-at-Large" help center, which is a call-center resource for Masons who do not reside on a Masonic Home campus.

Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice greater Akron, Cincinnati, Dayton, and Toledo were chosen to participate in Mercy Health's Coordinated Care Network.

Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice and Ohio Living Lake Vista, through its MyIndependence program, have partnered with Kindred House Calls to provide primary care physician services for independent living residents in the comfort of their own home.

Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice in greater Akron, Cleveland, Columbus, Toledo and Youngstown received their CHAP accreditations for hospice services. The CHAP (Community Health Accreditation Partner) seal of approval ensures that an organization has met – or exceeded – the highest standards of quality and compliance.

Our greater Youngstown location was a NorthCoast 99 Employer of Choice Winner, awarded by ERC. This awards program honors 99 great workplaces for top talent in Northeast Ohio.

Ohio Living Home Health & Hospice, greater Youngstown, Business Development Director Kate Davis and Ohio Living Foundation Gift Planning Director Susan Berny were among 18 nominees for the 25th annual Regional Chamber ATHENA Award Program.

# **Telehealth Monitoring**

We were featured in "LeadingAge" magazine showcasing how we are using telehealth technologies to better serve our patients. The article stated that we have become an early adopter of such technology-based monitoring through implementing strategies to reduce hospital readmissions for patients with congestive heart failure and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. 
# **Honorable Mention**




They are making a valuable impact on people by supporting some of the most important things in their lives.

They are things that promote health and wholeness. Things that expand horizons. Things that bring people together.


Interestingly, these really aren't things at all. What they've given are health, connection, dignity, faith, peace of mind, joy, discovery, and love.

In the pages that follow, we'll share the Ohio Living Foundation's performance details that underlie the real accomplishments – helping people live their lives to the fullest.


#### **Total Assets** (in Thousands)




#### **Total Number of Gifts & Donors**




# $\textbf{Total Giving Performance} \ \textbf{(in Thousands)}$









# **Accomplishments**

Chief Foundation Officer Tom Hofmann co-chaired the National Philanthropy Cabinet for Leading Age, Ohio Living's national trade association. In this role he commissioned an Urban Institute study of charitable giving to aging services in the US. As the first study of its kind, a national report was published titled *Giving and the Golden Years*, a spotlight piece from the publication Giving USA.

IMAGINE Ohio Living, a program fostering innovation throughout the organization, was developed and pilot tested. The Ohio Living Innovation Fund was also established to provide monetary support to new ideas that further the goals of Ohio Living.

The Ohio Living Foundation hosted the first ever Philanthropy Summit on April 12, 2017.

Approximately 200 board, staff, and resident leaders in the Ohio Living system attended this full day of training and celebration. Four educational tracks were offered, with presenters including Ohio Living Foundation staff and several external experts.

Ohio Living Breckenridge Village launched a capital campaign, Encore: Expanding the Plaza, Enhancing the Experience. This \$2.2 million initiative will expand the Osborne Community Plaza creating a large performing arts center, a bistro, a patio, and a parking lot expansion.

Ohio Living Swan Creek launched the campaign Gateway to Good Living to upgrade and transform many of the shared areas, and support endowment. Phase one is already funded and underway, with major upgrades to the entryway, lobby, and public areas of the apartment building nearly complete. Phase two, scheduled for spring/summer of 2018, includes external improvements to the campus entry landscaping.

The Ohio Living Foundation has implemented the Caring Fund, which offers emergency financial assistance to Ohio Living employees experiencing catastrophic events through no fault of their own.

Gift Planning Director James R. Hickey, CAP, CFRE, was honored with the Excellence in Fundraising Award from LeadingAge Ohio. Jim serves as gift planning director for Ohio Living Breckenridge Village.




